The Explorer Club career education program is for young men and women who are in the sixth, seventh, and eighth grades (ages 11–14).

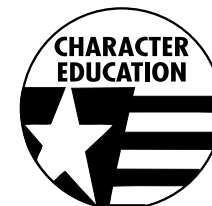


An Explorer club's purpose is to provide experiences to help young people mature and become responsible and caring adults. Explorers are ready to explore the meaning of interdependence in their personal relationships.



Exploring is based on a unique and dynamic relationship between youth and the organizations in their communities. Local community organizations initiate a specific Explorer club by matching their people and program resources to the interests of young people in the community. The result is a program of activities that helps youth pursue their special interests, grow, and develop.

Explorer clubs can specialize in a variety of career skills. Exploring programs are based upon five areas of emphasis: career opportunities, life skills, citizenship, character education, and leadership experience.





## **Explorer Club Vision**

*To provide positive and meaningful real-world career experiences  
and leadership development opportunities for all teenagers and young adults  
in their chosen field of interest.*

### **Organization Certification**

The executive officer of the participating organization, by signature, approves the club application. Prior to this, the executive officer must also approve all participating adults.

### **Group Participation**

Clubs are required to pay an annual Unit Liability Insurance Fee of \$40. This cost shall be submitted with the club application for participation and will help defray the expenses for the general liability insurance program.

### **Explorer Club**

Each club is required to have two adults.

### **Age Requirement**

All adults must be 21 years of age. Each Explorer club must list the correct Explorer club career interest code.

### **Special Needs Designation (if applicable)**
